THE DETAILS

The re:imagine/DREAMFest will be held in Atlanta December 6-7 2019. Young people ages 14 - 24 from across the globe may submit their work to the festival using FilmFreeway starting in Spring 2019, through October. Submissions will be viewed and scored, selected films will be notified throughout the fall. Final screenings and awards will be announced at the festival in December.

Categories will include Animation, Narrative, Documentary, Smartphone film, Silent Film and Music Video.

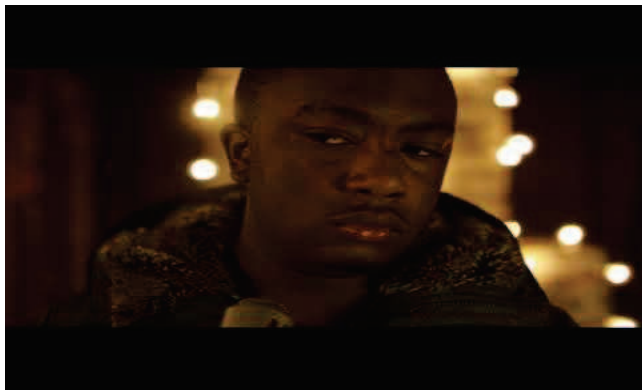
In addition to screenings, the festival will include workshops, industry panels, and time for networking among student peers and industry professionals.

Judges will be chosen from the film and entertainment industry, and will work closely with student leaders.

The festival will be open to the public for screenings, workshops and panel events.
